JSVFest (Jerk, Seafood & Vegan Fest)/International Festival of Life (IFOL) COVID-19 Pandemic Rules for all participants, attendees, and the general Festival guide, rules and regulations.

COVID-19 PANDEMIC RULES TO ADHERE TO:

1. All attendees must have their temperature check at the first point of entry.
2. All attendees and participants must be fully vaccinated to enter the festival and will be given special wristband that must be worn throughout the festival. If failed to wear the wristband, he/she, must wear a mask.
3. There will be COVID-19 Rapid-Test for unvaccinated patrons, who must wear a mask while on the festival ground and will not be given COVID-19 wristband. If at any time an unvaccinated patron fails to wear his/her mask, the festival COVID-19 Scouters will ask that they leave the festival ground and there will be no refund to anyone.
4. Unvaccinated attendees must show proof of a negative test result within the last three days. WITHOUT WHICH, 10-15 MINUTES COVID-19 RAPID TEST STATION WILL BE ON SITE FOR TESTING.
5. COVID-19 VACINATION STATION MAY BE AT HAND FOR UNVACCINATED ATTENDEES TO GET THEIR SHOTS.
6. FREE FACE MASKS MAYBE AT HAND FOR THOSE WITHOUT; ALONG WITH HAND SANITISERS .
7. ALL ATTENDEES WILL BE SEARCHED AT BOTH ENTRIES.

Admission Tickets: \$20 (subject to change without notice, if not purchased). Children under the age of 12 are free but must be accompanied by an adult. At the gate tickets will be \$30

Security/Weapons: The Morrison Imperial Investigation Security, Inc. under the supervision of Chief Joel Stanford will be the official Festival of Life Security. Note no weapons of any kinds are allowed in festival or on festival site. Anyone caught attempting to enter ground with any form of weapon will be arrested and weapon will be seized and turned over to the police.

Except for senior citizens, attendees will be searched upon entering the festival grounds. The following items will not be allowed: guns, knives, glass products or other weapons, video cameras, pets or drugs of any kind.

Re-entry: There will be no re-entry in the festival; except to deliver large items purchased from vendors, then a special permit will be given.

Transportation: We strongly suggest you take the train/El, bus or bike to the festival.

If you're travelling from within the Chicagoland area, please use these means to help plan your trip: Chicago Transit Authority (CTA), Pace Bus and Metra Rail.

PARKING: Parking will be limited. Stay tuned for parking options and bicycle accommodations.

Bike: Bike parking is available on site for those riding. You must provide your secure lock and key.

Walk/Jog: Easy summer walk or jog to festival, within the 1 to 2 miles surrounding/radius of Lake Meadows Park.

Food and Beverage: No outside food or beverage are permitted, except 6 sealed 16 ounces bottles of water in small cooler maybe allowed.

Alcoholic Beverages: Absolutely, no alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the festival site. On site there will be licensed Beer and Wine booths to serve festival attendees, who are 21 years and older. Should any caught consuming or sell unauthorized alcoholic beverage, such person will be arrested and/or removed from the festival site for the rest of the festival weekend.

Recordation: No video recordings of performers are allowed during artist performance.

Recording of Attendees Likeness/Photograph: By entering the festival site attendees (you) give the rights to promoter, when and where possible, to videotape photographed or filmed your (attendee) likeness and use the same as producers deem necessary in any or all media, include the Internet.

WHAT AM I ALLOW TO BRING? You may bring, portable/lawn chairs, blankets, cell phones, amateur cameras, your personal items, sunglasses, dominos, playing cards, tennis rackets, umbrellas, binoculars and other family games.
